Life Satisfaction

• 6.6 out of 10 is the average life satisfaction score among respondents. This is down slightly from the level of 6.7 measured in October 2023.

Feeling Safe in the City Centre

• 69% of respondents felt safe in the city centre during the day (similar to October 2023). 37% felt safe in the city centre at night - up from 35% in October 2023.

Looking After Babies or Toddlers

• In the general population **7%** of panel respondents were looking after their own child or children aged up to 3 years old. 2% looked after babies / toddlers for others, and 21% had looked after a child or children aged up to 3 years old in the past 5 years.

Moving Around Dublin City with a Baby and / or Toddler

- Among toddler caregivers, **78% walked / wheeled** to get around Dublin city with a baby and / or toddler. **60% used a car** and **55% used the bus**.
- Dublin City Council area residents were more likely than others to walk / wheel, bus or bike.
- The average time spent out and about with a baby / toddler on a typical day was **1.5 hours**.

Activities Engaged in with Babies / Toddlers

The most common activities engaged in when out and about with babies / toddlers were going to parks / playgrounds / green spaces (93% engaging) and going
to the shops for grocery / household shopping (85%). The majority of caregivers also engaged in organised activities / playdates, getting together with friends for
a walk or to sit down, going to a library, and taking the child to childcare.



Ease of Getting to Services

• Toddler caregivers reported good levels of ease in terms of getting to services with babies / toddlers. 93% felt it was easy to get to the library, 92% felt it was easy to get to parks / playgrounds / green spaces and 90% felt it was easy to get to shops for grocery / household shopping.

Challenges Encountered Moving Around Dublin City

• When moving around Dublin city with a baby / toddler, **81%** of caregivers reported encountering **challenges with footpaths** and **79%** encountered **challenges with toilets**. A majority encountered challenges with public seating and rest areas (56%), using public transport (55%) and crossing the road (52%). 47% encountered challenges with public bins, 33% with play spaces, and 29% with using a private car.

Challenges with Footpaths

- The top 3 challenges associated with the condition of footpaths were dog poo, uneven surfaces and litter.
- The top 3 challenges associated with obstacles on footpaths were vehicles parked on the footpath, domestic / commercial bins, overgrown hedging / trees.

Challenges with Toilets

- The top 3 challenges associated with toilets were that toilets are difficult to find, not easy to access and lacked suitable baby changing areas.
- Poor maintenance of toilets was more keenly observed by toddler caregivers than non-toddler caregivers.

Challenges with Public Seating

• The top 3 challenges associated with public seating were not enough public seating, seating not suitable for babies / toddlers and seating not in areas that provide shade and shelter.



Challenges with Public Transport

• The top 3 challenges associated with public transport were that public transport is hard to access with a pram or buggy, hard to access for those with a mobility challenge, and not having enough options / connections.

Challenges with Crossing the Road

• The top 3 challenges associated with crossing the road were obstacles (such as parked cars) blocking the view of traffic, not enough pedestrian crossings, and pedestrian crossings not in the right place.

Challenges with Public Bins

• Not enough bins and bins full / overflowing were challenges encountered by toddler caregivers.

Challenges with Parks, Playgrounds and Green Spaces

• The top 3 challenges associated with parks, playgrounds and green spaces were a lack of areas suitable for toddlers to explore nature, few or no suitable play facilities for toddlers, and dogs not under control by their owners.

Challenges with Using a Private Car

• Not enough designated parking spaces for people with young children and people taking up designated parking spaces without an obvious need were the most commonly experienced challenges with using a private care among baby / toddler caregivers.



Changes in Movement Around Dublin since Becoming a Caregiver to a Baby / Toddler

- The top 3 changes in how caregivers' movement around Dublin had changed since becoming a caregiver to a baby / toddler were:
 - Being more aware of challenges with public transport (space, frequency, timetables, routes)
 - Being more aware / restricted by which areas are accessible / quiet / have facilities / need to plan
 - Going to the city centre less or not at all / staying more local / suburban

Positive Aspects of Getting Around Dublin City with a Baby / Toddler

- The top 4 positive aspects of getting around Dublin city with a baby / toddler as given by caregivers in their own words were:
 - Range / accessibility / maintenance of parks, playgrounds and green spaces
 - People are friendly and helpful (including bus / Luas staff and passengers)
 - Bus accessibility or service is good or improved
 - · Luas accessibility or service is good or improved

Changes Suggested for Improving Getting Around Dublin City with a Baby / Toddler

- The top 4 suggestions for improving getting around Dublin city with a baby / toddler as given by caregivers in their own words were:
 - Improve footpaths / wider footpaths / dishing, general accessibility of paths / lighting along paths
 - Better public transport generally (including accessibility, consideration of needs, platform gaps etc.)
 - More / better / accessible toilets / public toilets
 - More regular / frequent public transport / more bus routes / more bus stops



Availing of Childcare

- Among those responding to the survey with dependent children in the household, 57% availed of childcare provided by others outside of the home.
- For 71% of these the setting of childcare outside the home was a crèche.
- For getting to the crèche, 47% walked / wheeled. 39% walked / wheeled to a childminder's home, 32% walked wheeled to a relative / friend's home, 49% walked / wheeled to a breakfast club or after-school club, and 41% walked / wheeled to a community childcare service.
- For all childcare services the distance of travel to access these services was shorter within the DCC area when compared with other Dublin local authority areas.
- 38% of those availing of childcare outside of the home indicated that there are services nearer their home that they would like to use but do not use. In 91% of cases the reason for not using these nearer services was that there were no places available.

Age of Independent Travel through Neighbourhood

- When asked at what age a child should be able to travel independently though their neighbourhood, the average suggested age was 10.8 years old.
- The most important factor for people in assessing a child's readiness for independent travel was the safety of the neighbourhood, followed by their emotional maturity.

Background to this survey





- Online survey, 21st February 3rd March 2024
- 1,024 respondents from the "Your Dublin, Your Voice" opinion panel
- 22% response rate
- Margin of error +/- 3.0% for general population
- Supplemented by 760 additional respondents from target demographic of toddler caregivers
- Total responses available for analysis = 1,784
- Of these, 1,066 are caregivers to babies / toddlers or have been in the last 5 years






- For measures specific to the topic of interest (e.g. accessibility of the city to toddlers and their caregivers) we supplement the core responses with additional responses from the targeted cohort.


Respondent Profile – general population panel only n=1,024









with dependent children in household




Profile of Toddler Caregivers n=1,066




Feeling Safe in the City Centre - Trend




Feeling Safe in the City Centre - by toddler caregiver y/n





DCC area residents more likely than others to walk / wheel, bus or bike.




What are your main ways of moving around Dublin city with a baby and / or toddler? by local authority



Moving Around Dublin City with a Baby and / or Toddler - by monthly income










Activities Engaged in with a Baby / Toddler - by monthly income



















































Do you avail of childcare for a child / children of <u>any age</u>? by monthly income





Setting of Childcare Outside of Home - by age group





Setting of Childcare Outside of Home - by local authority








How do you usually get to the childcare services that you use?












Factors in Assessing Readiness for Independent Travel - by gender identity
